


- A church where Jesus is at the centre

Being a mature disciple means: GROWING IN KNOWLEDGE OF THE SON

²⁸ He is the one we proclaim, admonishing and teaching everyone with all wisdom, so that we may present everyone **fully mature in Christ**. ²⁹ To this end I strenuously contend with all the energy Christ so powerfully works in me.

Colossians 1:28-29

¹¹ So Christ himself gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers, ¹² to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up ¹³ until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.

¹⁴ Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of people in their deceitful scheming. Ephesians 4:11-16 ²Like newborn babies, crave pure spiritual milk, so that by it you may **grow up** in your salvation, ³ now that you have tasted that the Lord is good.

⁵ For this very reason, **make every effort** to add to your faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; ⁶ and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; ⁷ and to godliness, mutual affection; and to mutual affection, love.

²⁵ Do not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encourage one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

Being a mature disciple means: SERVING ONE-ANOTHER IN LOVE
